A nocturnal, family-friendly bike ride in partnership with the Wood Co. Park Dist. will be held on Friday, Sept. 26 from 7-9 pm! Illuminate your bike with bright decorations and learn important safety tips for riding at night. Each rider is required to wear a properly fitted helmet and ride a safe, correctly sized bicycle, in working order. This is a recreational ride at a speed comfortable for all riders, roughly 3-miles round trip up the Slippery Elm Trail and back. Young riders that are not able to participate on their own should be in a tow behind trailer or child bike seat, no training wheels allowed. Decorating will occur at 7 pm in the Wolfe Community Room.

Adult volunteers are appreciated for decorating assistance. Ride begins shortly after 7:30 pm.

The FREE September View & Chew movie will be the action comedy "Bride Hard" starring Rebel Wilson.

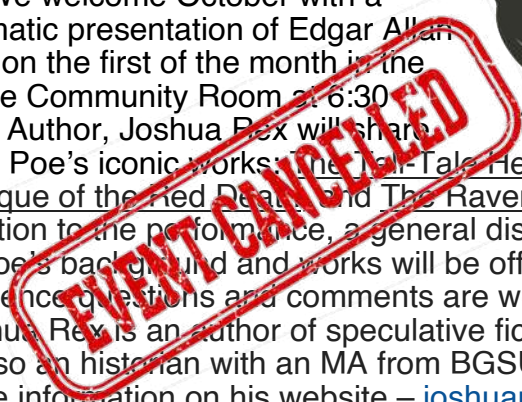
When a mercenary group takes a lavish wedding hostage, they have no idea what they are in for as the maid of honor is actually a secret agent.
